- Reviewed and discussed policy with Policy Committee on two (2) separate occasions

Rollout Plan

<u>Phase 1</u>: Hire School Safety Officers and place in high schools that previously had SROs

■ Begin hiring in Spring of 2020

Phase 2: Place officers in middle schools that previously had SROs

Phase 3: Place officers in other middle and high schools and assigned to cover elementary schools in area
