# RESOLUTION 2020-5 RESOLUTION DECLARING OHIO COUNTY, KENTUCKY A SECOND AMENDMENT SANCTUARY

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States is the supreme law of our nation; and

**WHEREAS,** The Second Amendment to the Constitution states, "A well-regulated militia being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed"; and

**WHEREAS,** The United States Supreme Court has affirmed an individual's right to possess firearms, unconnected with service in the military, for traditionally lawful purposes, such as self-defense within the home; and

**WHEREAS,** The United States Supreme Court has affirmed that the right of an individual to "keep and bear arms", as protected under the Second Amendment, is incorporated by the Due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment against the states; and

**WHEREAS,** The United States Supreme Court in United States v. Miller (1939) stated that firearms that are part of ordinary military equipment with use that could contribute to the common defense are protected by The Second Amendment; and

**WHEREAS,** the Ohio County Fiscal Court is concerned about the passage of any bill containing language which could be interpreted as infringing the rights of the legal citizens of Ohio County to keep and bear arms; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio County Fiscal Court wishes to express its deep commitment to the rights of all legal citizens of Ohio County to keep and bear arms; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio County Fiscal Court wishes to express opposition to any law that would unconstitutionally restrict the rights of the legal citizens of Ohio County to keep and bear arms; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio County Fiscal Court wishes to express its intent to stand as a Sanctuary County for Second Amendment Rights and to oppose, within the limits of the Constitution of the United States and the Commonwealth of Kentucky, any efforts to unconstitutionally restrict such rights,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the People of Ohio County, through their duly elected Fiscal Court, hereby designates Ohio County a Second Amendment Sanctuary in order to preserve for the people of, on, and in Ohio County, their rights guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States of America; furthermore

That the Ohio County Fiscal Court hereby expresses its intent to uphold the Second Amendment rights of the legal citizens of Ohio County, Kentucky; furthermore

That the Ohio County Fiscal Court hereby declares its intent to oppose any infringement on the right of law-abiding legal citizens to keep and bear arms; furthermore

Ohio County Fiscal Court demands that public funds of the Commonwealth of Kentucky not be used to restrict Second Amendment rights or to aid in unnecessary and unconstitutional restriction of the rights under the Second Amendment of the legal citizens of Ohio County to bear arms; furthermore

Ohio County urges the General Assembly, the United States Congress, and other agencies of State and Federal government not to adopt, accept or enact any provision, law or regulation that may infringe, or place any additional burdens on the rights of law abiding legal citizens to bear arms; furthermore

This Resolution is not intended in any way to be temporary in nature; furthermore

The Fiscal Court of Ohio County requests the Ohio County Judge Executive cause true copies of this resolution to be forwarded to the County's representatives in the General Assembly and the United States Congress and to the Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
