





# Operations – Summary of Evidence


- Public input on design of new schools

- 751 site visits conducted to monitor compliance with nutrition services requirements through 1st semester



#### **IDEA**

#### **Challenges**

- Opportunities for specialized classrooms
- Ability to monitor full compliance in every school site
- Disproportionality in discipline

#### **Improvement Strategies**

- Regular meetings with KDE
- Support of ECE Implementation coaches in all schools via district-level supervisors and mandatory monthly training
- Provide on-going professional development for school leadership
- Conduct regular records review to monitor implementation of procedures and compliance
- Reorganize special education department to prioritize support to schools





# IDEA – Summary of Evidence

- Over 940 record reviews conducted from August through December
- Begin 3-year rollout of reorganizing student due process files to increase compliance and boost efficiency
- 130 ECE Implementation coaches hired and trained (increasing number of coaches for 2020-2021 school year)
- Special Education CAP Compliance trainings to-date (trainings are on-going)
  - ARC- 23 sessions 412 participants
  - FBA/BIP 51 sessions 1076 participants
  - IEP 52 sessions 1,373 participants
