SCHOOL DATA:

Examples:

According to the school report card 46.9% of students scored proficient or distinguished on the reading assessment.

The number of absences due to basic needs issues has increased by 6% since last year, according to the guidance counselor.

Based on school nurse documentation, the nurse averaged 20 student visits a day during the 2013-2014 school year. Head lice and bed bugs accounted for approximately 20% of those referrals.

Based on the 2019 school report cards 58.5% of North Todd students scored proficient in reading and 50.3% in Math. 58.7% of South Todd students scored proficient in reading and 64.0% in Math.

Based on Health Department documentation, each school nurse averaged between 30 and 40 student visits each day during the current school year. This increases if there is a virus outbreak. Medication, and virus symptoms are the biggest issue. Head lice is an ongoing problem.

Three counseling services provide in school counseling for students during the school day. Dental service is provided in school by a contracted agency, the health dept. and Western KY University.

COUNTY/DISTRICT DATA:

Examples:

The local ADD office (Department of Aging) reports that the number of grandparents in this county having custody of grandchildren increased by 20% within the last two years.

A recent county health department report states that 65% of our children receive little or no dental care.

According to the 2019 KY Kids County, 48% of children on medical card receive dental services. Only 60% of child support is collected in Todd County. In 2018 there were 212 children on WIC, 711 Receiving SNAP benefits, 41 on TAP and 56 on SSI. 52% of the population are below the 200% Poverty level. 92 children receive child care subsidies and 73 participated in HANDS. There is an average of 40 children in foster care during each year.
