- **Continued professional development in Rtl strategies**



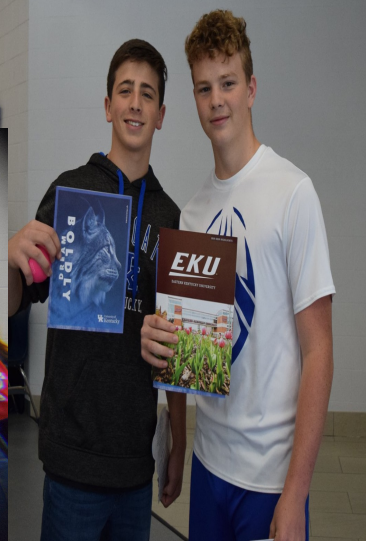
# *Transition Readiness*
