VI. Turnaround Team News

Discussion:

The Turnaround Team consists of meeting certain goals and criteria and to increase proficiency and growth. The team meets with weekly PLC's and revisions are discussed and implemented by the Leadership Team. Learning Walks are conducted by the Leadership Team to provide teachers with an opportunity to observe evidence-based practices. Teachers will complete the "name and claim" process and have engaged in goal setting with the students. Interventionists have been involved to help with tutoring such as 21st Century CCLC, Gear Up and ESS. We have Americorp volunteers and Gear Up tutors to provide support during classroom instruction. Curriculum is being updated and progress monitoring is being conducted. The team will engage in formative assessments and analyze assessment results. Behavior interventions are also in place and the system includes data monitoring, incentives and anchor lessons. A support plan for co-teaching will be implemented. We are cultivating the graduation rate via Persistence to Graduation report, monthly meetings, home visits and implementation of the Positive Behavior Intervention System (PBIS). CTE support is being applied and we are continuing to create opportunities via 18 career pathways projected for the 2020-21 school year. Some of those include Agricultural Education, Criminology, Education, Engineering, Health Science and JROTC. This will prepare students to be college and career ready by providing care academic skills, employability skills and technical job-specific skills.
