- Our fifth grade students enjoyed their annual overnight trip to Camp Joy on Feb. 19<sup>th</sup> through Feb. 21<sup>st</sup>. They raised the needed \$13,000 for the trip through fundraisers, business donations, staff donations, etc. During the three-day trip, the students participated in cultural history activities, adventure activities (ie. high ropes courses), and a living history reenactment (The Underground Railroad). We are grateful for the hard work of staff members for making this trip possible for our students.
