Teaching and Learning Initiatives & Highlights

- The Curriculum Department's work focused on these main areas this month:
 - Collaboration with the Education Recovery Staff from KDE
 - Attended various regional meetings as NKCES, including Grants Consortium, Title, & Professional Learning Consortium
 - Conducted District Instructional Meetings with principals to discuss curriculum, instruction, & assessment updates
 - Amy continues to assist each of the schools with finalizing renovations for their MakerSpaces and their Media Centers
 - Rachel is collaborating with each school on the implementation & monitoring of their Federal Funds
 - Attended school level PLC meetings to provide assistance to teachers
 - Rachel and Amy attended the River Cities Hub Network meetings and the Navigo meetings with NHS
 - Participation in each school's Admin Team meetings
 - Rachel collaborated with other NKY schools to revise & resubmit the new Perkins V Grant
 - Rachel is working with Gateway & other River City districts to be more intentional about the alignment of courses and career pathways for students
 - Participated in Scholastic Walkthroughs at NPS & NHS to collect data, provide feedback, & plan next step for improvement within their Reading classes
 - Amy & Rachel assisted the BACs & EL Staff with the organization & implementation of ACCESS Testing for all of our students currently in the EL Program
 - Participation in KDE webinars & February DAC/BAC training to learn about the upcoming changes to the assessment system along with all new requirements for Spring 2020
 - Conducted multiple meetings to plan for the Spring ACT Testing at NRS, NSOI, & NHS
 - Carla is serving as the BAC at NSOI to train the new Counselor effectively for future testing sessions
 - Amy worked with NIS Science & Social Studies teachers on January's PLC Day to plan next steps for improvement in these content areas
 - Linda is guiding all of the 30-60-90 Day Plans at each school to ensure they are focused on the needed improvement areas while also aligning the work with their new CSIPs
 - Amy collaborated with other leaders in NKY to plan & implement EdCamp for educators around the region
 - Participation in the Newport Hall of Fame event
 - Amy conducted multiple BAC meetings to plan for the upcoming ACT testing along with the KPREP Online Pilot Testing
 - Collaboration with NHS leaders and teachers on planning for their Master Schedule for 2020-2021
