

EXTERNAL CAPSTONE PROJECT NON-DISCLOSURE AGREEMENT

This Capstone Project Non-Disclosure Agreement is hereby entered into on this 23 day of January, 2020 between Jefferson County Public Schools ("Company") and the individual students whose contact information is ~~listed~~ below their signature line below.

WHEREAS, Company desires to be an Industry Collaborator and support and/or participate in an instructional/educational curriculum pedagogy referred to as a "Capstone" design project in which a team of students work with a faculty advisor(s) to apply techniques and processes in the classroom with "real world" projects of a business entity that will provide students with the opportunity to gain valuable experience while working with industry on an engineering design project; and

WHEREAS, Company acknowledges that in order for Company to participate in such projects that the individual students working on these projects will need to be apprised of and abide by provisions addressing the use and protection of Company confidential/proprietary information;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

I. Responsibilities of Students

Each Student is expected to work on the Capstone Project as described in the attached Exhibit A. Each student working on the Capstone Project agrees to sign this Non-Disclosure Agreement indicating their agreement to abide by the provisions for the handling of Company Confidential Information. University nor its faculty advisors are to provide student(s) access to Company Confidential Information unless the student has agreed to these obligations of confidentiality contained in this agreement, including all Exhibits.

II. Academic Records and Presentation/Publication Rights

The Student Capstone Project Team or individual student(s) may publish findings that arise from the Capstone Project. The respective student or students agree to provide Company with copies of proposed presentations and associated materials created by the student team members that are intended for an audience of University affiliated participants (e.g. those other faculty, staff or students who might attend a Capstone design project classroom presentation) and other materials that student(s) will complete as assignments for the course in which the student(s) is enrolled for the Capstone Project which would be shared with individuals who have not agreed to obligations of confidentiality (collectively referred to as "Class Publication Materials") and will be given five (5) business days to review the proposed Class Publication Materials and, if necessary, require the modification to or deletion of any reference to Company's proprietary or Confidential Information such that the class presentation can be conducted in a timely manner within the time framework associated with the course and the faculty advisor can appropriately document the students' assignment(s) to permit the grading of the Class Publication Materials. If Company should determine that changes

are necessary to the Class Publication Materials, the student(s) will work with Company to make the appropriate modifications in the Class Publication Materials so that the intended classroom presentation(s) is not unduly delayed and the students can complete their coursework requirements in a timely manner for the course associated with the Capstone Project.

B. Company will be furnished copies of all other proposed publications and presentations (i.e. those which are not Classroom Publication Materials) and will be given thirty days (30) to review the proposed publications or presentations and, if necessary, request that the student(s) modify or delete any reference to Company's proprietary or Confidential Information. Student(s) agree to comply with any such request(s).

C. Company acknowledges that Class Publication Materials may constitute student records within the meaning of the University policies and/or the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA"). Company agrees to work with University and the faculty advisor(s) to review such completed work for the inclusion of any Company proprietary and/or Confidential Information. Should any such Company proprietary and/or Confidential Information be found, Company will work with University to appropriately redact the materials or separate them in such a way to permit other University access to student records without the need to prevent access to entire sets or groups of student records associated with the Capstone Project. Company agrees to protect such student records and will not disclose such records to a third party without the permission of the respective student and to protect the identity of the respective student. Each student participating in said Capstone Project hereby grants Company an appropriate FERPA authorization so the needed Company representatives can review the student created materials in accordance with FERPA access provisions.

D. Company acknowledges that external accrediting entities and their representatives may request the review of Class Publication Materials to assess and evaluate the curriculum and instruction practices of University. Company agrees to permit University the right to share such representative Class Publication Materials appropriately redacted to not disclose Company proprietary and/or Confidential Information with the external accrediting entities and their representatives. Company agrees to be judicious in its redaction requirements to permit as broad as possible access by the accrediting entities and their representatives while still protecting Company's proprietary and/or Confidential Information.

III. Confidential Information

All Confidential Information disclosed by the Company to the student(s) in conjunction with this Agreement shall be held in confidence by the receiving party in accordance with the terms of the Reciprocal Non-Disclosure Agreement (Exhibit 2) (the "Confidentiality Agreement"), hereby incorporated by reference. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Confidentiality Agreement, the respective terms and conditions of that agreement (except as permitted via Section II of this Agreement) shall remain in full force and effect for purposes of this Agreement with

respect to disclosures of Confidential Information made throughout the entire term of this Agreement, as if it were set out fully herein.


