I. Call to Order

Chairman Joe Ray Thornbury called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

II. Public Comment

III. Student Achievement

A. Student/Staff Recognition

Pikeville Junior High School MathCounts Team and their coach Mrs. Ginger Mullins for their recent performance at regional competition. Students earned six of the top eight places, which were Eli Tan, Andrew Ferguson, Noah Howie, Collier Fuller, Adrian Shepherd, and Aneesh Sharma. Adrian Shepherd placed third overall qualifying him for state competition as an individual. Aneesh Sharma placed first qualifying him for state competition and giving him a full tuition scholarship to the University of Kentucky, a \$1,000 4-year scholarship to Western Kentucky University and a \$500 scholarship from the Kentucky Society of Professional Engineers. Andrew Ferguson, Noah Howie, Aneesh Sharma, and Eli Tan competed as a team of four and placed first qualifying their team for state competition. Team members were: Andrew Ferguson, Collier Fuller, Noah Howie, Isabella Mulkey, Aastha Patel, Allara Parsons, Aneesh Sharma, Adrian Shepherd, Eli Tan, and Tylee Theiss.

B. PES Principal's Report

Principal Robert Jones shared updates regarding the archery team's performance at regional competition, academic team results from district Governor's Cup, teacher flexible professional learning progress, results from the recent school safety assessment, details regarding the upcoming on-line field test, plans for professional learning around the new social studies standards, recognition of all staff and particularly janitorial staff for their efforts in reducing the spread of illness with cleaning routines.
