To whom it may concern,

The high school has been an active Unified Championship School through the Special Olympics of Kentucky for the past two years. The goal is for students with and without disabilities to work together to create a more inclusive school environment with the focus on everyone's abilities. We have successfully completed one season of Unified Track and Field and are entering into our next season. KHSAA also recognizes Bowling as a Unified Sport. The Bowling season begins in the late fall and ends in early February. We would like to pursue creating our own team to compete at the beginning of the 2020 school year.

As with every sport, we will strive to have meaningful practices to help prepare to compete in the tournaments. Due to the location of the nearest bowling alley in Vevay, Indiana or having to travel to Florence this may cause a barrier. When discussing with the Director of Unified Championship Schools, we would not be penalized for having practices with practice pins, such as they use in gym class.

In the past two years, I have received a grant of \$1500.00 to use for our Unified Club and Athletic programs. These funds will purchase uniforms, transportation costs, and shoe rental.
