The high school has been an active Unified Championship School through the Special Olympics of Kentucky for the past two years. The goal is for students with and without disabilities to work together to create a more inclusive school environment with the focus on everyone's abilities. We have successfully completed one season of Unified Track and Field and are entering into our next season. KHSAA also recognizes Bowling as a Unified Sport.
