Pikeville High School - Prom Contract 2020

We are excited about the upcoming Junior/Senior prom that will be held at UPike's HPE 7th floor pavilion. We are looking forward to a fun time for our students. The dance will begin approximately at 8:00 pm and conclude at 11:00 pm. In order to ensure that the PHS Junior/Senior Prom is a success for everyone, we have adopted the following guidelines:

- 1. **Dress Code**: Prom is a formal event and the evening should reflect both class and fun. Please come dressed elegantly and appropriately. Designated administrators and teachers will determine violations in dress. Choosing not to comply with the dress will result in removal from the dance for the entire evening. If you have any questions about Dress Code, please ask an administrator prior to Prom. Appropriate attire is defined below:
 - a. Jacket and tie or tuxedo
 - b. Dress of appropriate length, no front cut-outs, plunging necklines, and the back of the dress must fall at the natural waistline.
- 2. <u>Tobacco, Alcohol, Drugs, Controlled Substances, Drug Paraphernalia</u>: The use, possession, or sale of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, narcotics, drug paraphernalia and any other illegal substances is prohibited on school property or at any school-sponsored event/activity.
 - **a.** Students may be subjected to a random search at the discretion of school personnel. Refusal to cooperate with such procedure is grounds for non-admittance or removal.
 - **b.** Students or quests deemed to be in possession or under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be removed immediately and face disciplinary consequences.
- 3. **Dancing:** Dancing must be modest and not in any way lewd or suggestive. The chaperones reserve the right to determine appropriate dancing.
- 4. <u>Attendance:</u> The administration of Pikeville High School reserves the right to deny admittance to Prom due to prior discipline concerns at previous dances or events, during the school day. A PHS student (or guest) suspended or expelled from school at the time of dance is not eligible to attend the dance. Students who have 6 or more unexcused absences and have not completed all required Saturday School sessions are not eligible to attend the dance.
- 5. <u>Arrival:</u> Students must arrive by 8:30 to be admitted to the dance. Students arriving after 8:30 will be denied entrance.
 a. Once a student (or guest) leaves the dance, they will not be permitted to re-enter the event.
- 6. <u>Tickets:</u> All tickets are non-refundable, regardless of the reason. The guest ticket is valid only for the guest named. It may not be used by anyone else. Only one guest per Pikeville High School student is allowed to attend the dance. PHS students and their guest must arrive and depart together.
- 7. <u>Contracts:</u> All students attending PHS Prom must have signed a Behavior Contract prior to the dance. Pikeville High School students are responsible for the behavior of the non-Pikeville student guest and could face removal and/or discipline consequences for any inappropriate behavior.
- 8. <u>Students not attending PHS</u>: All PHS students must hand in his/her own behavior contract to attend Prom. Students not attending PHS must not be over the age of 20 and complete the form on the back of this sheet. If any information on the Behavior Contract or Guest Permission form is found to be falsified, PHS student and guest will not be permitted to attend Prom and no ticket refund will be given.
- 9. <u>Entrance to Prom</u>: All guests attending Prom must show their ticket as well as a photo ID (ex. permit, license, school ID, or Infinite Campus Student Summary w/Picture) to be permitted.

By signing below, I agree to uphold the rules set forth in the PHS student handbook as well as those outlined above. I understand that if I am in violation of these rules, I will be asked to leave Prom and could face school and legal consequences.
