**WHEREAS**, the Henderson County Board of Education is committed and resolute to the progress of public education in Henderson County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kentucky General Assembly passed legislation in the 2020 session under SB 177 declaring an emergency in the Commonwealth of Kentucky due to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) public health crisis which is having an immediate and significant impact on public schools and providing emergency relief to all public schools; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the Henderson County Schools to respond in support of our community amidst the current public health crisis, caused by COVID-19.

**NOW, THEREFORE:** It is hereby RESOLVED and ORDERED by the Henderson County Board of Education in response to the above described state of emergency:

1. The provisions outlined in SB 177 shall be adopted and implemented to the extent necessary to facilitate the administration of educational services and the operations of the Henderson County Schools.
2. The Superintendent of Henderson County Schools shall be authorized to act on the Board's behalf in implementing any necessary provisions set forth in SB 177 and any corresponding regulations or administrative orders.
