



Live RED at Home Days COVID-19—Update

The Livingston County School District has been implementing the NTI program since in-person classes were cancelled as recommended by the Governor and Commissioner of Education. During this COVID-19 time, participation is reported differently than during regular NTI days. Districts track and report student participation rates by the week. The idea is that staff connect with all students at least once during the week in whatever way necessary. Currently in-person classes are cancelled through May 1st.
