# 1. General

i.

- a. Formal Observations/Site Visits
  - Certified Teachers/Other Professionals
    - 1. Formal observations that have not been conducted as of 3/13/2020 will NOT be required in order to conduct a summative evaluation.
  - ii. Principals/Assistant Principals/District Level Administrators
    - 1. Site Visits that have not been conducted as of 3/13/2020 will NOT be required in order to conduct a summative evaluation.
- b. Summative Evaluations
  - i. Summative evaluations shall be conducted via a virtual format (e.g. Zoom, Google Meet, Microsoft Teams).
  - ii. Electronic signatures are acceptable on all summative evaluation forms.
- 2. Non-Tenure
  - a. Formal Observations
    - i. The number of formal observations that occurred up to 3/13/20 will be sufficient for a summative evaluation.
  - b. Summative Evaluation
    - i. The summative evaluation will occur, regardless of how many formal observations were conducted prior to 3/13/20.
    - ii. The summative evaluation will occur via virtual means with electronic signatures on all forms.
- 3. Tenure T1/T2 in 19-20
  - a. Formal Observations
    - i. If the formal observation for the 19-20 school year had not been conducted as of 3/13/20, the observation will occur in the 20-21 school year.
    - ii. T2 in 20-21 will receive 2 formal observations in the 20-21 school year
    - iii. T3 in 20-21 will receive 2 formal observations and one summative evaluation in the 20-21 school year
- 4. Tenure T3
  - a. Formal Observation
    - i. If the formal observation for the 19-20 school year had not been conducted as of 3/13/20, the observation will be waived for the 19-20 school year.
  - b. Summative Evaluation
    - i. The summative evaluation will occur, without the 3rd formal observation.
    - ii. The summative evaluation will occur via virtual means with electronic signatures on all forms.
