

## **MUNICIPAL ORDER 12-2020**

**A MUNICIPAL ORDER AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPLICATION FOR A FY2020 COMPETITIVE GRANT THROUGH THE KENTUCKY 911 SERVICE BOARDS IN AN APPROXIMATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$130,000.00, THE PROCEEDS OF WHICH WILL BE UTILIZED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO TO PURCHASE CONSOLE FURNITURE FOR USE BY THE OWENSBORO-DAVISS COUNTY CENTRALIZED 911 COMMUNICATIONS CENTER; A TEN PERCENT (10%) MATCH BEING REQUIRED BY THE CITY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Owensboro-Daviess County Centralized 911 Communications seeks to file an application for a FY2020 Competitive Grant through the Kentucky 911 Service Boards in an approximate amount not to exceed \$130,000.00, the proceeds of which the City of Owensboro will purchase console furniture; and

**WHEREAS**, the current furniture was purchased in 2009 upon consolidation of the Dispatch Center as basic office furniture. The furniture is utilized twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week without interruption, therefore, has sustained wear and tear over the years; and

**WHEREAS**, a ten percent (10%) match is required of applicants for this grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a grant application to be filed with the 911 Emergency Service Boards for the FY2020 State 911 Emergency Service Board Program for grant funds in an approximate amount not to exceed \$130,000.00, the proceeds of which the City of

Owensboro will purchase console furniture, for which a ten percent (10%) match shall be required from the City.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor, City Manager and appropriate staff members are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all other agreements, instruments or documents necessary and appropriate to effectuate and implement any grants awarded to the City.
