Review of previous minutes

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed; there were no comments.

Schedule

Alliance advised that the current estimated completion date will be revised to the week of November 8, 2009. Alliance had previously advised, at the progress meeting of February 11, 2009, that no work was performed 10 days in December 2008, 22 days in January 2009 and 5 days in February 2009, due to inclement weather. The new estimated completion date is based on these weather-related delays.

Shop drawings

Shrout Tate Wilson (STW) advised Alliance that the following shop drawings have not been re-submitted for review and acceptance.

- 1. P1 P1A: Bemis model #1055, rejected August 8, 2008. Seat shall be Bemis model #1955c.
- 2. P7A: Rejected August 8, 2008; fixture is not ADA compliant.
- 3. EWH-3: Rejected August 8, 2008. All water heaters are to be obtained from a single source.

Change Orders/ASI

- 1. SCB advised that the Hardin County school board accepted Change Order No. 3 on July 16, 2009 (refer to attached Itemization of Change Order #3).
- 2. SCB referred to "ASI Itemization" (copy attached to these minutes).

Pay request

Immediately following this progress meeting, SCB processed Application and Certificate for Payment No. 14 and submitted copies to the Owner.

Record drawings

John DeBrabander of Alliance Corporation is responsible for maintaining "as-built" documents throughout this project.

Daily clean-up

SCB and Alliance advised that all affected areas must be kept secure and free of excess debris. Alliance reminded all subcontractors to maintain a clean project site, and again advised that subcontractor debris not removed when requested will be removed by Alliance at the subcontractor's expense. Alliance further advised that smoking, beverages other than water, and food will no longer be allowed in the building.

Safety issues

New business

- 1. Owner's comments: None at this time.
- 2. Architect's comments: None at this time.
- 3. Consultant's comments:
 - a. Mike McGaughey, of STW, asked about the status of the geothermal well drilling. Alliance advised that the driller is still averaging one and one-half wells per day. Alliance further advised they will take whatever measures are necessary to assure all wells are in place to maintain the project schedule.
 - b. Mike advised that the Hardin County Water District has rejected the fire service vault currently installed adjacent to Hwy. 333. STW and Alliance will further review the issue following this progress meeting.
 - c. Mike also requested that Alliance provide the cost estimate for relocation of the water service adjacent to Hwy. 333.
- 4. Contractor's/Subcontractors' comments: John DeBrabander reviewed the following schedule.
 - a. All sub-contractors are to remove excess materials and relocate all office and storage trailers.
 - b. All traffic onto the project site, including for deliveries, is to utilize the Hwy. 333 entrance. Access through the North Hardin High School property will no longer be available.

Next scheduled meeting

The next progress meeting will be held Thursday, August 27, 2009, at 9:30 a.m., inside the new building, exact location to be determined. All persons must access the project site through the Hwy. 333 entrance.
