PULASKI COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
DISTRICT FACILITIES PLAN HEARING REPORT*

A public hearing was held at the central office on 02/27/20, at 5:30 PM. The purpose of the public hearing was to propose a new District Facility Plan developed by the Pulaski County Local Planning Committee. The Local Planning Committee (LPC) voted 12-0 in favor of the proposed new plan and the Board voted 5-0 to approve the new plan.

There was no one from the community in attendance. Tim Eaton KSBA Field Consultant, served as the locally appointed hearing officer. Mr. Matt Cook, the Assistant Superintendent, was present representing the district.

COMMENTS


The hearing officer called the public hearing to order. The hearing officer outlined the purpose of the hearing and the hearing procedures in accordance with 702 KAR 1:001. The hearing officer read through the agenda. Again, there was no one present to speak or no written comments submitted. The hearing officer read highlights of the proposed new District Facility Plan which includes under Major Renovation 1c., major renovation to B.E.S, including demolition to the 1951 existing freestanding disconnected classrooms and construction of a cafeteria addition, plus a custodial receiving addition. Under 1d., also at B.E.S., construct 2,000 sf. of identified program space plus a family resource center. District LED interactive screens are included for all classrooms at B.E.S. Under item 1e., renovation to all 15 existing facilities to upgrade the most current life safety requirements of The Kentucky Building Code. Under Capital Construction Priorities 2c., major renovations are listed for PCHS, SWHS, Pulaski DTC, NMS, SMS, EES, NES, OHES, PES, SHES, SES, and Memorial Education Center. Replacement and upgrades to HVAC controls are listed for Pulaski ATC, the Adult Ed. Center and Northern Elementary. Under Discretionary Projects (5) 1. PCHS has listed synthetic turf for the football field, LED lighting replacement for the baseball field and LED lighting for the football field. 2. SWHS also is listed for synthetic turf for the football field along with a baseball concession building to be constructed. 3. Northern Elementary shows a kitchen addition of 550 sf. 4. Replace all lighting throughout the district with LED lighting. 5. Replace all sports field lighting throughout the district with LED lighting. 6. Upgrade all gymnasium lighting at all facilities with LED lighting. 7. At the Central Office, replace all areas of parking and drives, replace existing roof, and provide additional parking.

There was no one present to comment and no written comments submitted.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the new District Facility Plan as developed by the Pulaski County Local Planning Committee and adopted by the Pulaski County Board of Education be approved as the District Facility Plan for the Pulaski County School District. A copy of the new plan is attached.
