

Lincoln Elementary School

May 2020

- LES teachers worked very hard to provide intentional and engaging work for our students during this time away from school. All students received four NTI packets during our NTI days.
 - Distribution #1- Green folders – (Days #1-10) – 94% returned
 - Distribution #2 - Yellow folders – (Days #11 – 20) – 89% returned
 - Distribution #3 - Red folders – (Days #21-30) – 79% returned
 - Distribution #4 - Folders geared toward continued summer learning – Not to be turned in

- During our NTI days, certified teachers at Lincoln interacted with students via phone, video conferencing, etc. Using the data submitted by LES certified teachers and administrators, the weekly participation rates are:
 - Week 1 – 98% participation rate
 - Week 2 – 93% participation rate
 - Week 3 – 99% participation rate
 - Week 4 – 96% participation rate
 - Week 5 – 98% participation rate
 - Week 6 – 99% participation rate

Total NTI Participation Rate - 97.1%

- Classified staff members have stayed involved and active by supporting staff and students during these most uncertain times. They made learning games, prepared packet materials, assisted with food deliveries, supported their collaborating teachers, helped deliver items to students' homes, etc.
