APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

03.121 Certified Salaries, 03.221 Classified Salaries

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

All salaries for certified personnel shall be based on a single-salary schedule providing, at minimum, for the number of working days required by law. All regular and substitute classified personnel shall be employed and paid on an hourly or salary basis as established by the Board. The 2020-21 Classified Salary Schedule has been modified to show a delineation between "Exempt" and "Non-Exempt" positions as defined by the Federal Labor Standards Act (FLSA), resulting in two classified pay scales; the current "G-scale" for non-exempt, hourly positions and an "S-scale" for exempt, salaried positions.

Supplemental Pay Schedules reflect adjustments recommended by Management. The Classified Salary Schedule reflects a 1% increase throughout the entire schedule. The increase is in addition to the employee step for another year of experience.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

Addition of approximately \$330,000 from General and Special Revenue Funds

Approval of the 2020-21 Supplemental Pay Schedules and 2020-21 Classified Salary Schedules as presented.
