

## **MUNICIPAL ORDER 14-2020**

### **A MUNICIPAL ORDER AUTHORIZING THE OWENSBORO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO DONATE A SURPLUS VEHICLE TO THE OWENSBORO COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE TO BE UTILIZED AS A TEACHING TOOL FOR STUDENTS IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, in 2010, the Owensboro Police Department (OPD) purchased a 2011 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN #2FABP7BVXBX120923; and

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle was originally purchased to be utilized as Police Cruiser Unit 41-633 by the OPD, but based upon make, age, and mileage considerations, has been retired for use under the City's motor vehicle replacement policy; and

**WHEREAS**, KRS 82.083(4)(a) authorizes a city to transfer real or personal property without compensation to another governmental agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the OPD has a surplus of vehicles and desires to donate the 2011 Ford Crown Victoria to the Owensboro Community and Technical College to be used as a teaching tool by its students in the Criminal Justice Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the City of Owensboro, Kentucky, by and through the Owensboro Police Department, is hereby authorized, in accordance with KRS 82.083(4)(a), to donate a 2011 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN # 2FABP7BVXBX120923 to the Owensboro Community and Technical College. The vehicle is of no further use to OPD and the Owensboro Community and Technical College has agreed to pay all fees

or costs with having all lettering on the vehicle removed or changed. The vehicle will be utilized as a teaching tool for students in the Criminal Justice Program.
