- CVES gained support from an SRO officer, Deputy Richardson. Mr. Richardson supported the school during specific events that arose throughout the school year.
- The 86 Fire Dept. hosted a Fire Safety program for Preschool-5th grade students
- Ms. Joy Cox received the honor of being the CVES ExCEL Nominee & Teacher Finalist for HCS
- Activities were coordinated for our school community through our Family Resource Center & Coordinator, Ms. Donna Propes (i.e., monthly Bruin Lunch Bunch, Open House, KinderCamp, Cumberland Dental program, Veterans Day & Stay Well screenings for staff, Cradle School -birth to 5yrs)
- Ms. Neuman, School Counselor, organized Student of the Month Luncheons to honor students and provide an opportunity
- Music and Art Teacher, Candace Dailey, hosted a winter Music performance
- Principal, Ms. Kiser, FRC, Ms. Donna Propes, and Counselor, Ms. Neuman, conducted individual student goal-setting conferences with third-, fourth- and fifth-grade students

- CVES Green Team (energy club) met monthly and conducted energy audits in classrooms

All three Cecilia Valley Teams qualified for State. Two of our three teams qualified for Worlds in Louisville. (COVID prevented Worlds from taking place)
- Ms. Cox led Volleyball Team in a successful undefeated season
- Our BETA Club was led by Tiffany Neuman and Carla Scott. A 5th grade student placed in the writing competition.
- The CVES Academic Team had a very successful year with individual students placing 1st place in social studies, 2nd place in written composition, 3rd place in written composition, 5th place in science and 5th place in math at the district competition. Our Quick Recall Team finished in second place and advanced to Regionals. Our Future Problem Solving Team finished second and advanced to Regionals. At the regional competition held on February 29, our FPS team placed 3rd.
- The 4th and 5th grade Boys' Basketball Teams, coached by Brooke Gregory and Parent volunteers, made great growth this year.
- 5th grade traveled to ECTC for a book festival where students could meet and interact with authors
