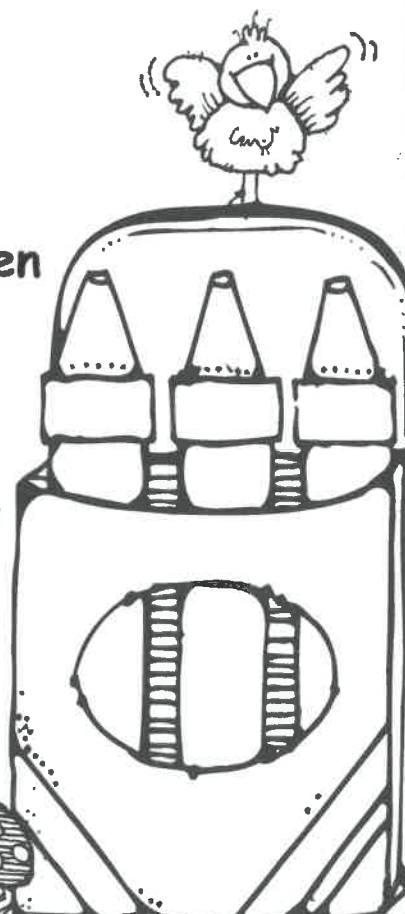

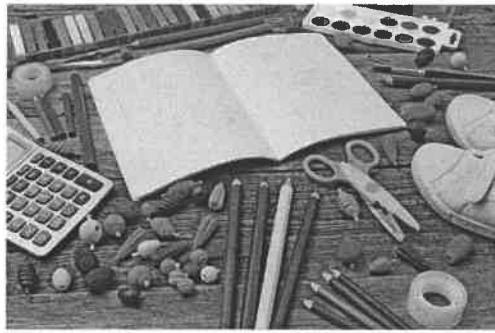
## Ms. Holly's Supply List

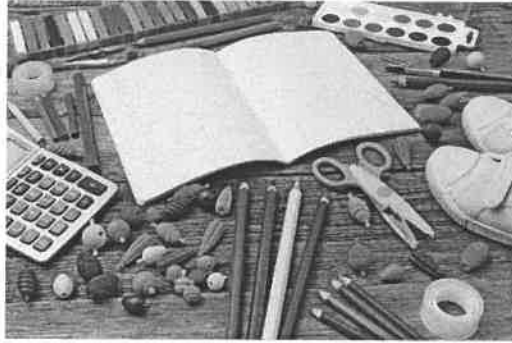
