After due process, the Board of Education will forward an executive summary to the Louisville Metro Planning Commission. Those wishing to comment will step to an X marked on the floor in front of a podium and look and speak into a laptop to begin the video recording. The speaker will have a maximum of three minutes. At two minutes and 30 seconds, a bell will sound to indicate that there are 30 seconds left.
