

MUNICIPAL ORDER 17-2020

A MUNICIPAL ORDER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE FILING OF A CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND (CRF) APPLICATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF INCURRED EXPENSES IN CRF FUNDS WITH THE DEPARTMENT FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DLG); AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS WHICH ARE DEEMED NECESSARY BY DLG TO REIMBURSE CITY; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE AUTHORIZED CORRESPONDENT FOR REIMBURSEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Owensboro (CITY) desires reimbursement for expenses incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) on behalf of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that CRF funds are available to the CITY, pursuant to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), and impose certain obligations and responsibilities upon the CITY that require among other things:

- (1) Approval of a satisfactory application by the CITY transmitted to DLG for approval; and
- (2) Other obligations of the CITY in connection with receiving the CRF funds for the purposes stated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a CRF application on behalf of the City of Owensboro for CRF funds for reimbursement of expenses incurred by the CITY due to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19 shall be submitted to DLG.

Section 2. That the Mayor, City Manager and appropriate city staff are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all other agreements, instruments or documents, provide such additional information, and furnish such documentation as may be required by the DLG for reimbursement of expenses incurred due to the COVID-19 public health emergency.

Section 3. That the Mayor shall act as the authorized correspondent for reimbursement by the DLG.
