- 13 KRS 160.290 authorizes local boards of education to provide for courses and other services for
- 14 students consistent with the administrative regulations of the Kentucky Board of Education. KRS
- 15 156.850 requires compliance with federal provisions and acts relating to vocational education.
- 16 This administrative regulation incorporates by reference the Kentucky Academic Standards for
- 17 Technology, which contain the general courses of study and academic content standards of
