- 1121 Student/athletes
- 476 females/645 males
  - Spending more money on our female student/athletes than our male student/athletes
- 48% of our District high school student population are participating in athletics
- Survey

  - Were not able to give survey this year due to closure of in-person instruction
  - Plans are in place to give survey first semester this year

- June 8-12
  - Fall sports began meeting with their student/athletes
  - Each student/athlete was required to have a signed COVID-19 parent/guardian form and an updated physical
- Big thank you to Dr Bealle and Dr Rob and volunteers (West Ky Orthopedics/Jennie Stuart) for organizing free physicals for our student/athletes
- June 15—Phase One
  - Fall Sports could begin workouts that were comprised of physical conditioning activities
- June 29—Phase Two
  - All sports could begin workouts
  - Sport specific guidelines

- July 13-Aug 3—Phase Three
  - Current guidelines are the same as Phase Two
    - Golf can begin competition on July 31
    - Suspended all indoor non-Fall sports at the high school and middle school level
      - KHSAA: Local consideration should also be given to whether or not non-fall sports and sport-activities should be permitted
        additional activity at this time to allow for and promote a controlled return to fall sports, particularly in light of recent data
        from the Department of Health.
      - Our custodians are focusing their efforts on preparing facilities for the upcoming school year (limited time for the necessary additional cleaning of used indoor facilities after each team use).
    - Baseball and Softball can continue workouts as long as workouts are outside—indoor facility use is prohibited

Our current focus is and should be on Fall Sports—we want to give them (our student/athletes and coaches) the optimal opportunity to be as prepared as possible for their hopeful upcoming season. Our plan is to reinstate all sports August 3<sup>rd</sup>.

  - Cross Country—TBD
  - Golf—July 31
  - Soccer—TBD
  - Volleyball—TBD
  - Football—TBD

Next KHSAA Board of Control meeting is scheduled for July 28<sup>th</sup>, at which time we are hopeful to receive vital information relating to the start of other Fall Sport seasons. At that time, we will also review current District guidelines put in place and make any changes necessary to ensure the safe continuation of future athletically activities.

- Athletic Trainer update
  - Two District contracted trainers up to July 30<sup>th</sup>—one at each high school
  - Present Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday-Thursday
  - 5 hours per day
  - Available to all high school and middle school sports when they are on campus
- Virtual Learning Academy Eligibility
  - Any student enrolled in the CCPS Virtual Learning Academy is eligible to participate in extra-curricular activities as long as they meet the academic requirements to be established by CCPS.

- Would like to recommend to the Board that all coaching stipends be reinstated.
- With the implementation of all sports on June 29<sup>th</sup>, all coaches are fully invested in their teams.
- Our Coaches connected to over 1000 students
- Our Coaches have always had a vital role in our student/athletes lives, but now even more important role
- The Board would have the right to freeze stipends in the event of closure and if deemed necessary.
