Addition of a Math teacher at the Ignite Institute

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

01.11-General Powers & Duties of the Board

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The Ignite Institute is in need of an additional math teacher to help with the scholar load for two periods of math with the new logistics program as well as 4 more sections within the colleges. this is a result of scholars needing multiple math courses within the colleges during the same time. Adding a math teacher would alleviate the need for current math teachers to teach two math classes at the same time within Computer Science, Education, and Design. Finally, the Boone County Teacher Contract only allows for 150 scholars per day, per teacher. An additional math teacher would help us accommodate this requirement.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:


This will be a Boone County position. Kenton and Boone will split the cost of the additional math teacher. According to Boone County's salary schedule, this position could range from \$40,230 (no experience, rank III)-\$74,155 (30 years experience, rank I). This means that the financial responsibility of Kenton County will be half, ranging from \$20,115-\$37,077.50.
