- 9 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 156.160 requires the Kentucky Board
- of Education to establish courses of study for the different grades and kinds of common schools,
- with the courses of study to comply with the expected goals, outcomes, and assessment strategies
- developed under KRS 158.645 and 158.6451. KRS 156.070(1) requires the Kentucky Board of
- 13 Education to manage and control the common schools and all programs operated in the schools.
- 14 KRS 160.290 authorizes local boards of education to provide for courses and other services for
- students consistent with the administrative regulations of the Kentucky Board of Education. KRS
- 16 156.850 requires compliance with federal provisions and acts relating to vocational education.
- 17 KRS 158.102 requires boards of education for each local school district to establish and maintain
- 18 library media centers in every school to promote information literacy, technology in the
- curriculum, and to facilitate teaching, student achievement, and lifelong learning. KRS 158.791
- details the provision of high-quality library media programs to support reading proficiency. This
- 21 administrative regulation incorporates by reference the Kentucky Academic Standards for

- 22 Library Media, which contain the general courses of study and academic content standards of
- 23 library media for use in Kentucky's common schools.
- 24 Section 1. Public schools offering a library media program shall meet the minimum content
- 25 requirements established in the Kentucky Academic Standards for Library Media Elective.
