## Healthy at School Plan for Reopening 2020-2021

#### Purpose and Goal:

NIS will provide a safe learning environment for all students, staff, and faculty. We have created a plan that utilizes the guidelines provided by the Governor, Health Department, and Kentucky Department of Education. We want all students to have an opportunity to continue to grow in their education.

## Virtual School or Hybrid In-person School:

All parents and guardians will have an option to choose Virtual Learning or a Hybrid Model. Each school will be contacting all parents and guardians to discuss these options with each family and help families decide what the best option is for their child.

may change within our district and state.

Virtual Learning	<ul> <li>Students will have one teacher that will lead virtual learning for ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Writing.</li> <li>Students will complete the following daily:         <ul> <li>Approximately 1 Hour of ELA Content</li> <li>Approximately 1 Hour of Math Content</li> <li>Approximately 1 Hour of Science Content</li> <li>Approximately 1 Hour of Science Content</li> <li>Approximately 1 Hour of Social Studies Content</li> <li>Writing will be embedded throughout all content areas</li> </ul> </li> <li>Content for each content area can include technology time, Google classroom assignments, instructional videos, and google meet sessions for whole class and small group sessions.</li> <li>All Virtual Learning Assignments must be submitted by Sunday at 8:00PM for the prior week. If a student does not complete the work, they will not be counted as present for the school week.</li> </ul>

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Prin	Primary Procedures and Expectations	
Social Distancing	<ul> <li>Social distancing of 6 feet will be adhered to in all possible areas of NIS's campus.</li> <li>Markers on the floor throughout the building and in common areas such as the restroom will assist with social distancing.</li> </ul>	
Required Materials, Face Mask, and PPE	<ul> <li>Face masks shall be worn. Masks must be appropriate and adhere to NIS Dress Code.</li> <li>Students with a medical plan that prevents them from wearing a mask, you must provide a medical waiver or will be asked to participate in the virtual learning.</li> <li>When students are outdoors and 6 feet from others, masks are not required.</li> <li>At times and where possible, students may be provided a break from wearing a mask so long as they can social distance.</li> <li>Backpacks will be required for all students. Students will be taking their ipad and charger home daily with them.</li> </ul>	
Screening and Contact Tracing	<ul> <li>Temperature checks will be conducted upon arrival in the parking lot or building for all faculty, staff, and</li> </ul>	

	<ul> <li>students by touchless thermometers.</li> <li>Anyone with a temperature of 100 or more should remain home.</li> <li>If a student shows a temperature of 100 or more upon arrival to school he/she will be sent home and parents and/or guardians will be required to come to school and pick them up.</li> <li>Holding Area: <ul> <li>Outside: If the weather is nice and we are able to go outside, we will have an adult sit with the student until they have a parent/guardian pick them up</li> <li>Nurses Station: If the weather is not nice, we will have students outside the nurses station by the elevator. The students would walk outside the building and go in the door by the nurses station to ensure we are not walking through the entire building.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Sanitation and Environmental	<ul> <li>Washing of hands will be encouraged throughout the day particularly: <ul> <li>Before or after eating</li> <li>Before and after using the restroom</li> <li>When hands are soiled</li> </ul> </li> <li>Teachers and students will be encouraged to clean desks and other shared items as often as possible.</li> <li>A deep cleaning will take place on Wednesday and Friday Afternoon throughout the entire building.</li> <li>Each room will be cleaned daily</li> <li>Restroom will be sanitized after each classroom bathroom break</li> </ul>

Before School and Arrival	
Morning of school	<ul> <li>School doors will open for student entry at 7:30.</li> <li>Students will be required to sanitize their hands before entering the building.</li> </ul>
Bus transportation	<ul> <li>Utilize hand sanitizer before loading the bus</li> <li>Social distance at the bus stop.</li> <li>Face masks shall be worn on the bus.</li> <li>If possible, sit with siblings on the bus.</li> <li>Load the bus from back to front.</li> <li>The seat behind the driver will remain empty.</li> <li>If a student has a temperature when they get on the bus, they will be isolated upon arrival at school. The bus driver will communicate with the school to ensure we have someone there to isolate the student and</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>contact the students home.</li> <li>All bus drivers and monitors will have their temperature checked daily.</li> </ul>
Traffic control and Drop-off	<ul> <li>Students must come directly into the school upon arrival and not congregate in the parking lot or front entrance</li> <li>Temperatures will be taken in the parking lot for all students that are dropped off.</li> </ul>
Entrance into building	<ul> <li>Bus riders will have their temperature taken prior to getting on the bus and will enter through the main doors.</li> <li>Car riders will have their temperature taken in the parking lot and then will proceed to the side doors by the main entrance to enter the building and get breakfast.</li> <li>Walkers will enter through the main doors where they will have their temperature taken and grab a breakfast.</li> <li>Breakfast: Each student will get a grab and go breakfast and take it to the classroom to eat.</li> <li>Students will be required to use hand sanitizer prior to entering the building.</li> </ul>

	The School Day
Classroom	<ul> <li>Face masks shall be worn throughout the class if students are not 6 feet apart.</li> <li>Social distancing will be adhered to as much as possible with desks facing the same direction.</li> <li>Assigned seating shall take place in all classrooms.</li> <li>Tape will be on each floor to outline students' 6 foot space. Students will be required to put their mask on if they leave their six foot space.</li> <li>There will be hand sanitizer available for all students to utilize throughout the day.</li> </ul>
Changing of classes and Hallways	<ul> <li>Where possible, hallway and stairwell traffic will all move in the same direction. Arrows on the floor and walls will indicate the direction of traffic.</li> <li>Students will be staying in the same classroom all day for breakfast, lunch, instruction, and special area classes. Teachers will rotate to students.</li> <li>In places where traffic will go both ways, please move about on the right side of the hallway or stairwell.</li> <li>Stairwell 1 will be an up stairwell</li> <li>Stairwell 3 will be closed to traffic unless there is an emergency</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Stairwell 3 will be used for buses at dismissal time.</li> </ul>
Medication and Nurse	<ul> <li>If a student requires medication throughout the day the nurse will come to the classroom, pull the student to the hallway, provide a cup of water, and have the student take their medication.</li> <li>If a student requires a visit to the nurses office, the nurse will come to the classroom to get the student.</li> </ul>
Restrooms	<ul> <li>Procedures are in place to allow students to use the restroom.</li> <li>Each class will have an allotted bathroom time. If a student has to go outside that time, the teacher will radio to have someone escort the student to the restroom.</li> <li>Students will only use the restroom in their grade level hallway.</li> <li>Students will fill water bottles during restroom breaks</li> </ul>
Lunch	<ul> <li>Procedures are in place for students to eat in the classroom.</li> </ul>
Safety Drills (Fire, Earthquake, etc.)	<ul> <li>Safety drills will be conducted according to the provided guidelines with the main goal of minimization and the wearing of masks and social distancing.</li> </ul>
Visitors	<ul> <li>All visitors are prohibited inside the building until further notice and guidelines allow.</li> <li>You may contact the school at 859-292-3023 to schedule a meeting with a Principal, Teacher, or Counselor.</li> </ul>
Field trips and Assemblies	<ul> <li>Until further notice, no field trips or entire school assemblies will occur.</li> </ul>

	Dismissal and After School
Dismissal of students	<ul> <li>Students will be dismissed in two main segments and times:</li> <li>2:50 Bus Riders</li> <li>2:52: 2 Classrooms from Each grade Level</li> <li>2:54: 2 Classrooms from Each grade Level</li> <li>2:56: 2 Classrooms from Each grade Level</li> <li>Students will exit the building in one of the front doors or by the gym exit.</li> </ul>
Bus loading and Transportation	<ul> <li>All bus riders will be escorted to the gym from their classroom starting at 2:50.</li> <li>Students will sit in the gym, six feet apart, and wait to</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>load their bus.</li> <li>Students should load the bus from back to front.</li> <li>Students shall continue to wear masks for the duration of bus transportation to their drop-off location.</li> </ul>
Traffic control and Pick-up	<ul> <li>Student pick-up is in the front parking lot.</li> <li>Administration and faculty will assist with afternoon traffic control and dismissal.</li> </ul>
After/Before school activities	After school activities are currently cancelled including moving in the morning until further notice

Outside Agencies and Services	
Counseling	<ul> <li>External counseling services are a parent/guardian choice. Intakes are completed by the outside agencies' counselors and the parent/guardian.</li> <li>The counselor will go to the classroom to pick-up the student on her caseload for the student's counseling session.</li> <li>Hands will be sanitized upon entry for both the counselor and student.</li> <li>If the student and counselor are not 6 feet apart, a mask must be worn at all times during the session.</li> <li>The use of fidgets or other counseling manipulatives will be minimal. If used, the items need to be disinfected after each use.</li> <li>Upon completion of the in person session, students are escorted back to the classroom.</li> <li>The counseling office is disinfected after each student.</li> <li>Virtual students will participate in the counseling sessions virtually as approved through the external counseling agencies telehealth protocols.</li> </ul>
Big Brother Big Sister	<ul> <li>No in person Big Brothers Big Sisters program, virtual meetings will be conducted by the BBBS coordinator onsite at NIS.</li> </ul>
Care Closet	<ul> <li>Parents/Guardians will send in their student(s) size(s).</li> <li>Care Closet organizer will package the items of clothing to be sent home with the student(s).</li> </ul>
Food Pantry	<ul> <li>Families needing assistance will contact Kristy McNally to schedule an appointment to pick up food items. The appointments will be available during a</li> </ul>

specific time frame two days a week.
