AFFILIATION AGREEMENT

THIS AFFILIATION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into this 5th day of August, 2020, by and between SPALDING UNIVERSITY (UNIVERSITY), located at 845 S. Third Street, Louisville, Kentucky, 40203 and the Jefferson County Board of Education, on behalf of the OFFICE OF TRANSITION READINESS (OTR), located at the Van Hoose Education Center, 3332 Newburg Road, Louisville, KY 40218.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, UNIVERSITY offers one or more courses in Financial and Managerial Accounting, and

WHEREAS UNIVERSITY desires to participate in the Dual Credit Scholarship (DCS) and Work Ready Kentucky Scholarship (WRKS) programs administered by the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority (KHEAA), has so executed the KHEAA Dual Credit Scholarship Program Administrative Agreement, and is listed as a Participating Postsecondary Institution (PPI) and

WHEREAS UNIVERSITY desires to offer as a part of its curriculum an opportunity for students of Jefferson County Public Schools to enroll in online courses at Spalding University and earn academic credit from Spalding University and

WHEREAS, OTR collaborates with high schools within the Jefferson County Public School district and is capable of providing and desires to provide students dual credit for Financial and Managerial courses, and

WHEREAS, UNIVERSITY and OTR consider it mutually advantageous to cooperate to further the above-described purposes and desire to commit their entire agreement to writing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements and undertakings herein specified, UNIVERSITY and OTR agree as follows:

- 1. TERM: This agreement is effective from August 5, 2020 through June 30, 2021.
- 2. STUDENT LEARNING EXPERIENCES: Upon mutual consent of the UNIVERSITY and OTR, an instructor meeting the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACS-COC) faculty credentialing standards will be assigned to design the course according to UNIVERSITY guidelines and requirements. The instructors will possess credentials according to the requirements of UNIVERSITY faculty. The UNIVERSITY instructor named below will be teaching the following course for dual credit:
 - a) Dr. Ian Van Deventer ACC-261: Accounting I: Principles (3 credit hours)

3. UNIVERSITY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. UNIVERSITY will not discriminate against any student, instructor, employee or other person because of race, color, national origin, age, religion, marital or parental status, political status, political affiliation or beliefs, sex, sexual orientation, gender, identity, gender expression, veteran status, genetic information, or disability, or limitations due to pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions.
- B. Per Federal guidelines, students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP) will be connected to the UNIVERSITY'S Office of Accessibility Services (OAS).
- C. UNIVERSITY will provide instructor and enrolled students access to "Canvas" to be used as an assessment, teaching, and learning tool.
- UNIVERSITY will assign a Spalding e-mail addresses to instructor and enrolled students.
- E. UNIVERSITY will provide lab space (on a scheduled basis) on campus as requested and available.
- F. UNIVERSITY agrees to charge no more than the Dual Credit Tuition Rate Ceiling, equal to two-fifths (2/5) of the Kentucky Community and Technical College System in-state hourly tuition rate for the 2020-2021 academic year, regardless of the number of dual credit courses an individual student elects to take. Further, UNIVERSITY specifically agrees not to assess any other fees, including, but not limited to, equipment charges, laboratory fees, or other charges.
- G. UNIVERSITY understands that DCS and WRKS funds will only be disbursed for each eligible student with a grade greater than or equal to a D-; UNIVERSITY will be financially responsible in instances where dual credit students do not pass the course.
- H. UNIVERSITY will, upon successful completion of course requirements, verification of such, and the submission and posting of final grades, release an official UNIVERSITY transcript to each enrolled student upon request.

4. OTR RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. OTR will not discriminate against any student, instructor, employee or other person because of race, color, national origin, age, religion, marital or parental status, political status, political affiliation or beliefs, sex, sexual orientation, gender, identity, gender expression, veteran status, genetic information, or disability, or limitations due to pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions.
- B. OTR will facilitate class registration and require that STUDENTS complete and submit an Application for Admission and Dual Credit Course Registration form for each student to UNIVERSITY designee no later than August 28, 2020 for the class as outlined above.
- C. Through a program of self-insurance, OTR shall provide and maintain comprehensive general liability coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate. A certificate of insurance evidencing such coverage shall be provided to UNIVERSITY upon request.

5. <u>STUDENTS' RESPONSIBILITES</u>

- A. STUDENTS will meet all course requirements as outlined in the Syllabus.
- B. STUDENTS will complete and submit UNIVERSITY Application for Admission to the designated OTR representative.
- C. STUDENTS will complete and submit UNIVERSITY Registration Form to the designated SCHOOL representative for the course in which they want to enroll:

 ACC-261: Accounting 1: Principles (3 credit hours)
- D. STUDENTS may withdraw from the following course up until the following withdrawal deadlines:

ACC-261: Accounting I: Principles – withdraw by November 20, 2020 DCS grade report will reflect a "W" indicating course withdrawal.

E. STUDENTS enrolled in a dual credit course not covered by the Dual Credit Scholarship (DCS) will be responsible for payment of tuition charges not to exceed the Dual Credit Tuition Rate Ceiling, equal to two-fifths (2/5) of the Kentucky Community and Technical College System in-state hourly tuition rate per credit hour for the 2020-2021 academic year.
