



- Explore opportunities to integrate core academics with CTE


Improvement Strategies

CTE – Summary of Evidence



- Collaborated with KDE to automate 90 % of the state TEDS data collection system
- Improved transition readiness rates, compared with end of year rates from prior year
- Maintained all time high graduation rate of 82% (preliminary)
- Increased post-secondary opportunities for Class of 2020 graduates -
 - 3,275 students took Early Post-Secondary Learning Opportunities Courses
 - 1,515 students took Dual Credit (college level) courses, earning 6,798 college credit hours
- Built Central Office Process Map documenting all CTE related processes and protocols performed by staff
- Continued improvement of the Academies of Louisville structure-
 - Hosted virtual planning meeting with 100 business partner representatives
 - Waggener High School achieved NCAC Academy Status for their Freshman Academy


Challenges

Three Pillars








Percent of Students Meeting Benchmarks

Instructional Management – Summary of Evidence

Before NTI

- % students meeting grade level benchmarks are at or above last year
- Over 2,000 more GT identifications for students of color
- Developed <u>JCPS Teacher Backpack</u> and <u>Principal Backpack</u>
- Implemented 18 Comprehensive System Reviews

During NTI & Summer

- Served over 1.7 million meals
- Distributed over 20,000 devices
- 98% or higher of each student group participated at some point during NTI
- 4,707 ARC meetings held
- Over 6,000 students participating in summer learning opportunities



Onward Together, Opening School 2020

- Developed guiding principles Health/Safety, High-Quality Instruction,
 Flexibility, Equity, Accurate and Timely Communication, Community Trust
- Established district-wide committee with broad representation
- Hosted multiple opportunities for community input and feedback
- Board approved starting school on August 25 using NTI with regular evaluation points for moving to hybrid model – in person and virtual academy





NTI 2.0: Plan Highlights

- Consistency within and across schools and levels.
- Clear focus on a smaller number of evidence-based practices and quality resources to support learning outcomes.
- Simplicity to allow for effective implementation and monitoring.
- Thorough, focused professional learning for administrators and teachers.
- Coordinated orientations and trainings for families and community partners.

Racial Equity


