Facilities, Transportation, Safe Schools and Healthy at Work

Transportation:

- Working on current Hybrid bus schedule with Kathi Baldwin. At this point, we are trying to double check riders and determine if current stops still address locations of students. Will then compare to what a full time schedule would look like and issues related to transporting all students without utilizing TANK.
- TANK has stated they would have sanitized buses in the morning/afternoon routes for NHS students and would continue service at same cost as last year.

Facilities:

- Painting completed at NHS in classrooms.
- Ceiling tile and LED lights are completed at NHS.
- Water heater replacement at NHS has begun.
- Local Planning Committee members have been forwarded by Mr. Watts to the Commissioner. Waiting on Gary Leist to return to complete that process.
- Reviewing potential projects that we could take on in the short term to keep classified employed as we move forward. Possible projects could be: additional room painting, Stadium power wash and paint, take over lawn care for the remainder of the year, mulch beds and pull weeds, and additional painting as needed in district.

Safe Schools

- Each school has submitted their Safety and Trauma team members to me and they will be receiving information on how to do the virtual trainings for this year beginning in September. We will meet as a group, more than likely Google Meet, once we get started with the school year.
- NSOI has finally been granted access to the Navigate program and Mr. Snapp has completed his items.

- Hand sanitizer has now come in and we have plenty on hand. Schools also have a 55 gallon barrel apiece once the other sanitizer runs out to replenish their stock.
