 - Board approved 7 cents above the 4% rate to be implemented in 2020-21
- May 22nd Tax Recall Petition affidavit submitted to Jefferson County Clerk
- **July 10**th Recall Petition signatures submitted to the County Clerk
- August 10th Recall Petition Signatures certified "Sufficient" by County Clerk
- August 11th JCPS notified County Clerk to submit question to voters on November 3rd, are voters "for" or "against"?
- August 20th JCPS filed complaint challenging validity of recall petition signatures
- **September 5**th & **6**th Tax rates advertised in Courier-Journal
- September 15th Board update on tax rates for 2020-21
- November 3rd General Election

KRS 132.017 (3)(d) - If the ordinance, order, resolution, or motion fails to pass pursuant to an election held under paragraph (a) or (b) of this subsection, the property tax rate which will produce four percent (4%) more revenues from real property, exclusive of revenue from new property as defined in KRS 132.010, than the amount of revenue produced by the compensating tax rate defined in KRS 132.010, shall be levied without further approval by the local governmental entity or district board of education.

School Tax Rate

Rate if...

- Ballot issue passes or determination is made issue should not be on the ballot – rate will be 80.6 cents per \$100 assessed value
- Ballot issue fails rate will be 75.5 cents per \$100 assessed value, per KRS 132.017
