## Livingston County Board of Education Employee Benefits Dental and Vision Update October 2020

**Recommendation**: Renew the employee dental and vision plans with no changes for 2021.

- Rates remained the same for both the vision and dental plans.
- Benefits were shopped competitively with 8 companies.
- Networks were compared for favorite local providers.
- Michelle Keeling is doing a terrific job with the administration of the plan which is a big factor in how smoothly the dental and vision plans are running. In addition, service from The Life Associates, Inc. has been exceptional.

## **Dental Benefits**

Dental plan has no deductible and an annual benefit of \$1,000. Preventive services are covered at 100%, basic services at 80% and major services at 50%.

The Board covers the cost of the employee's dental premium, and the employee may elect dependent coverage at their cost.

## **Vision Benefits**

Employees may choose between two vision plans: the basic and the deluxe. The deluxe plan allows for frames every year, while the basic plan only allows for frames every other year. Employees enjoy a \$10 copay for their vision exam.

Employees cover the full cost of either vision plan.
