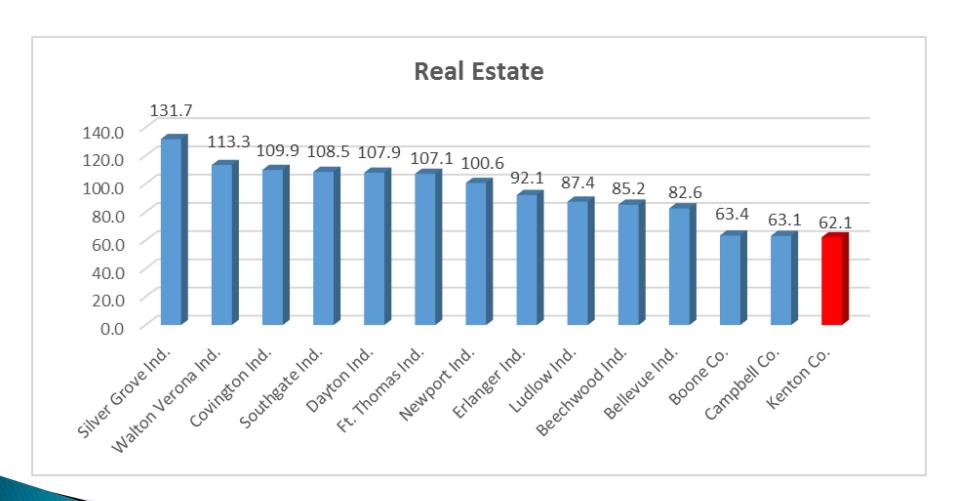

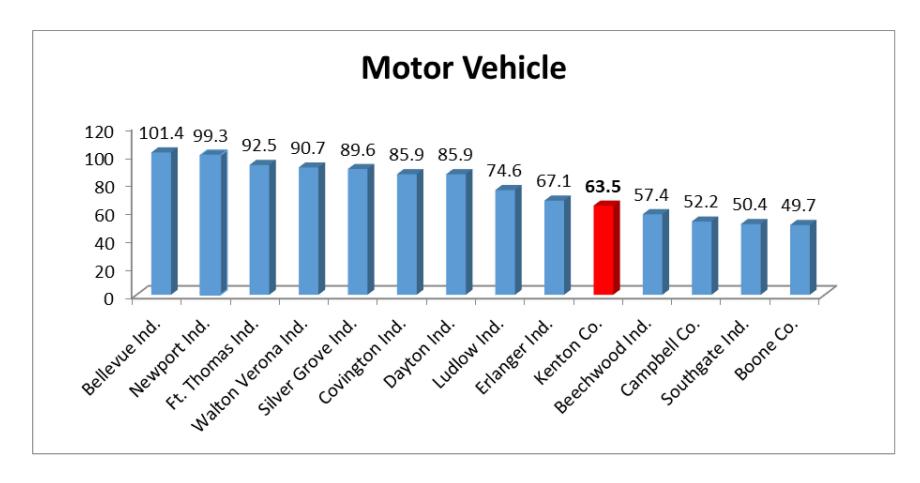

Northern KY School District Tax Rates 2016-17

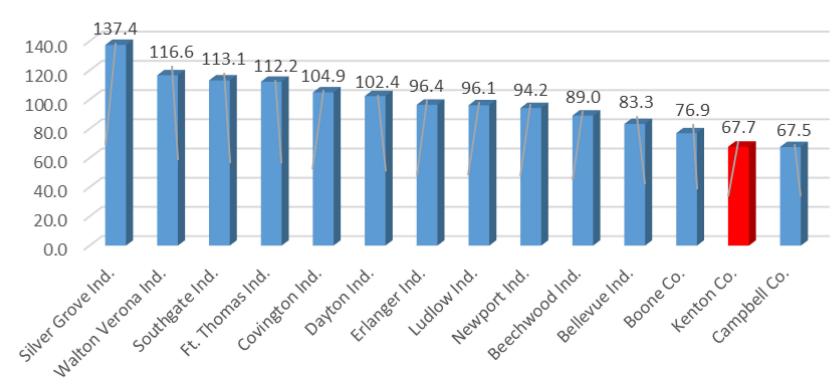


Northern KY School District Tax Rates 2016-17

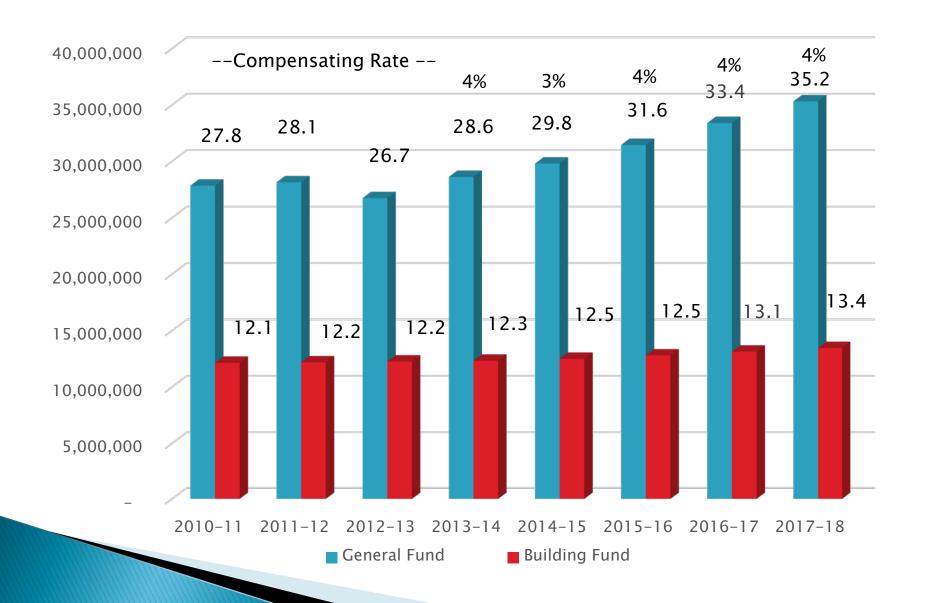

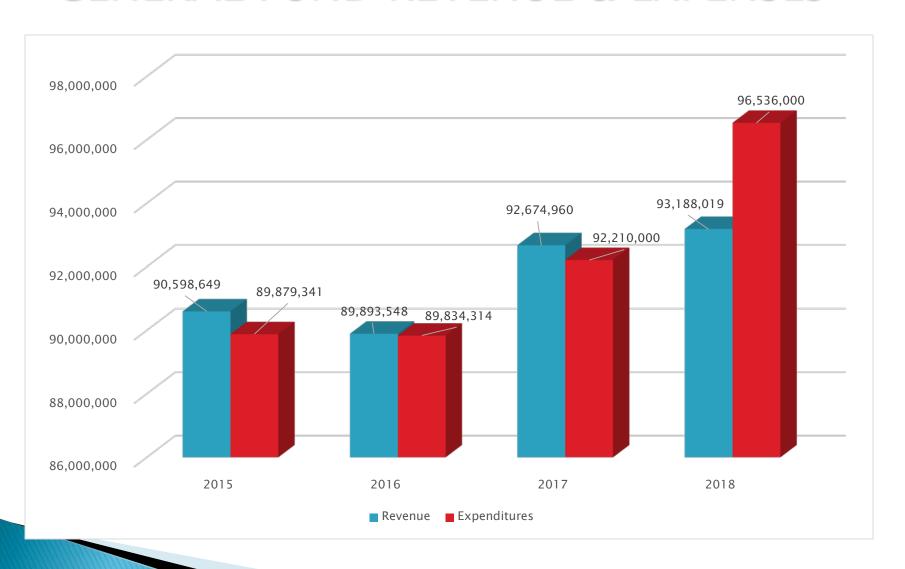
