Sports Information:

We have been practicing and participating in contests following the guidelines set forth by KHSAA and the Henderson County Board of Education. Our coaches and athletes have done an outstanding job following those guidelines. Our football team lost one game from their schedule and had to reschedule another game when 28 players were quarantined after playing against a confirmed positive. Both soccer teams lost multiple games due to "red" county status. We canceled with teams that were "red" and teams canceled with us after we turned "red".

The boys and girls golf team competed in the Regional Tournament on September 28 and 29. The boy's team was led by Grayson Coughlin (7th grader) with a 92 and Leland Cross (senior) with a 93. The girl's team was led by Maggie Hollis (freshman) with a 98 and Rylea Dixon (junior) with at 103, and they finished 6th in the region.

The Boys Soccer team finished the regular season with 4 wins, 2 losses and 1 draw. The two losses were both to Daviess County which has been consistently ranked in the top 10 in the state. The boys defeated Webster County 10-0 to win the 6th District.

The Girls Soccer team finished the regular season with at 5-1 record, only losing their first game of the year to a very seasoned team from Castle High School. The girls defeated Webster County 10-0 to wind the 6th District. The 2nd Region Girls Soccer Tournament will take place at Henderson County High School the week of 10/19.

The cross country team will be competing in the Regional Meet on Saturday (10/24). They are looking for a strong performance from the girls' team and possibly a return to the State Meet on 10/31.

The volleyball team will be competing for the 6th District Championship on Tuesday night.

The football team is currently 2-1 overall and 1-0 in the district.

The boys and girls basketball teams began conditioning outside on September 8 and was allowed to move indoors with no contact and medium sharing on 10/14.

October 26 – Boys and Girls Basketball

November 2 – Swimming and Wrestling

We plan on allowing these teams to begin practice on time. They will continue to follow all of the guidelines and restrictions put in place by KHSAA and Henderson County Schools. The current schedules have tournaments and out of state games. We would like to monitor the Covid infection rates before making any decisions to cancel those games.
