
MTSS Supports:

Racial Equity: Minority Hiring

- Principal Hires: 8 of last 12 hired are Black
- Largest number of Teachers of Color in JCPS: 1117
- Largest number of Black, Male Teachers hired in JCPS: 213
- Reduced Attrition of Black Teachers from 14% to 7%
- Hired 424 new teachers, 83 of which are teachers of color (20%)
- Louisville Teacher Residency: 30 residents, 23 are people of color



Current Incidence Map



Current Positivity Rate for Jefferson County


