- We have 33 juniors and seniors attending Gateway for Dual Credit classes this year.
- We have 23 juniors and seniors attending various programs at the Campbell County Vocational School.
- We have 3 students taking courses in education through NKU's School-Based Scholars program, which if they pass with a C or better, will earn them career readiness (if not already achieved).
- We have 5 students in the Logistics pathway at Gateway. If they pass both classes with a C or higher, they will earn career readiness, and be able to co-op in the Spring semester at a logistics company (i.e.; Amazon, DHL, Wayfair).
- We have 8 students in the Healthcare pathway at Gateway. If they pass their classes with a C or better, they will earn career readiness, and they have the opportunity to complete clinical hours in the Spring through St. Elizabeth.
- There were 6 seniors who took the first round of the KYOTE test on Friday, October 9th.
- 21 of the current seniors have completed their Senior Meetings with Mrs. Stallkamp. This is where the seniors begin completing FAFSA for college, discuss post-graduation options, and apply for colleges.
- We have been given acceptance letters to various schools for 4 of our seniors thus far.



- Graduating a member of the 2020 Greendevil Class tonight – this will count toward our 5 year graduation cohort
- CERT Testing for grades 9-11 took place on October 1st, 5th, 8th, and 12th
 - Students were tested in Reading, English, Math, Science
- Fall Break was on October 15-16
- Produce Pop-up took place on Thursday, October 15th was a success (Collaborative effort with Lincoln Elementary)
- Homecoming Parade and Recognition of Fall Court took place on Friday, October 16th
- Volleyball Team – Won First Conference Championship since 1991
