## HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The District posted a French teacher position at Simon Kenton on the District's employment website and the Kentucky Department of Education's certified vacancy website on 07/29/2020. There are currently no applicants who hold French certification. Applicant Kelly Loughead, who has been recommended for the French teaching position on an emergency certificate basis, holds a Masters of Arts in French, a Bachelor of Arts in History and Minors in French and Political Science, and served as a Teaching Assistant at the University of Kentucky for French courses.
