Covid Procedure Plans

Requirements of anyone attending practices/matches

- Masks will be required and must be worn appropriately at all times while in the bowling alley.
- Temperatures will be taken of anyone entering the bowling alley, using iHealth PT3 Infrared No-Touch Forehead thermometer.
- District screening questions will be asked at time of taking temperature.

General Cleaning & Sanitizing

- Hand sanitizer will be available using district-provided hand sanitizer bottles.
- Bathroom access will be limited; usage will be documented for contact tracing.
- Settee area/tables will be sprayed using district-provided PureSan sanitizing solution prior to practice/match.

Practice Procedures

- Bowlers will be limited to 4 bowlers per pair of lanes. There will be a pair of lanes separating each group of bowlers. Bowlers will not be allowed to intermingle outside of their grouping. Groupings will be documented for Contact Tracing purposes.
- Bowlers must supply their own equipment (towel, talc powder, wrist support, ball, shoes, etc). If a bowler does not have their own ball or shoes, then they may use such equipment provided by the bowling alley. The ball should be disinfected prior to usage.
- Only two bowlers will be allowed at any settee/table to promote social distancing.
- Practices will be restricted such that spectators will not be allowed within 2 lanes of any of the bowlers. Proper social distancing will be encouraged.
- Masks will be required and must be worn appropriately at all times while in the bowling alley. The mask may be lowered under the chin during the process of bowling, but must be placed back into position prior to leaving the foul line.

Matches

- Masks will be required and must be worn appropriately at all times while in the bowling alley. The mask may be lowered under the chin during the process of bowling, but must be placed back into position prior to leaving the foul line.
- Bowlers must supply their own equipment (towel, talc powder, wrist support, ball, shoes, etc). If a bowler does not have their own ball or shoes, then they may use such equipment provided by the bowling alley. The ball should be disinfected prior to usage.
- Only 6 bowlers will be allowed to participate in a match. Four bowlers will be used to bowl two normal games, with the two extra bowlers remaining at the settee/tables adjacent to the lanes the games are bowled on.
- There will be two lanes separating the teams from each school. There will be no intermingling of bowlers from each school either before, during or after the match.
- A five person team will be used to bowl two baker games. Bowler A will bowl the 1st and 6th frame, while Bowler B will bowl the 2nd and 7th frame, and so on.
- Transportation will not be provided and bowlers must find their own means of attending both practices and matches.
