

Henderson County High School Winter Sports Attendance Plan

In an effort to ensure the safety of the athletes, coaches, and fans of Henderson County athletics, Henderson County Schools will be implementing new rules and procedures for spectators at all Henderson County High School's athletic venues. These guidelines are subject to modification if necessary to ensure the safety of all involved.

General Guidelines

- Masks/face coverings are required at all times (must cover the mouth and nose area) - This applies to any sports venue inside or outside.
- Masks may be removed to eat and drink.
- Refusal to wear a mask will lead to removal from the venue.
- All high-risk individuals as defined by the CDC are encouraged to stay home.
- All individuals entering the venue will have their temperature taken and be asked health screening questions involving any symptoms and contact with others diagnosed with COVID-19. Individuals with temperatures higher than 100.4°F will not be admitted.
- All attendees are strongly encouraged to practice preventative measures such as social distancing, covering your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing, and frequent hand washing.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in various locations throughout the venue.
- Social Distancing
 - Family units may sit together, but use 6 feet of social distance between another family unit. Students in grade 8 and below must sit with family and must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
 - Social distancing (HC) stickers are marked 6 ft apart. Practice social distancing when waiting in lines at ticket booths, restrooms, and concession stands.
 - Avoid congregating inside or outside of our facilities.
- Spectators will be required to remain seated in the bleachers unless visiting the restroom or concession stand.
- The gate will open 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the first contest of the day.
- Post Game
 - Fans are asked to exit facilities immediately after the contest.
 - Congregating at the end of games is not permitted.
 - The soccer stadium will be dismissed by section.
- Concessions Stands
 - May or may not be offered depending on the event and venue.
 - Items will only include drinks and prepackaged food (chips, candy, etc.)

- Tournaments/Competitions
 - All spectators will be required to leave the school after the first game.
 - The bleachers, benches, locker room, scorer's table and restrooms will be sanitized before the spectators for the next game are allowed to enter.
 - Tickets for each game will be sold separately.
 - KHSAA maximum of 8 teams in the tournament.
 - There will be 2.5 hours between start times to allow for the school to be cleared and sanitized.

Venue Specific Guidelines

Colonel Gym - basketball

- The bottom section of bleachers behind the team benches will not be available.
- Folding chairs used for team benches will be spaced out to allow for social distancing while not in the game.
- The scorer's table will be space far enough away from the floor to allow for social distancing between players and workers at the scorer's table.
- Locker rooms will be available for use with a limited number of athletes inside at one time. We will start with a maximum of 6 individuals at one time.
- The Colonel's fan section will be both the lower and upper levels opposite the players benches.
- The visitor's fan section will be the upper level behind the benches.

Colonel Gym - Wrestling

- The lower level bleachers will be pushed in and all spectators will sit in the upper level.
- Seating for wrestlers will be spaced to allow for social distancing while waiting for their match.
- If a match has to take place in the auxiliary gym, spectators will be required to bring a lawn chair to maximize social distancing.

Colonel Gym - Dance

- Bleachers will be sectioned for the spectators from each school.
- Only spectators for the school performing will be allowed in the gym during performance.
- Bleachers will be sanitized before the next group is allowed to be seated in that section.
- The holding area for teams will be sanitized between groups.

Chase Fulcher Archery Center - Archery

- Spectators will sit in bleachers and chairs with social distance markings.
- Bleachers and chairs will be disinfected after each flight.

Arc Lanes Bowling Alley - Bowling

- Bowling matches do not charge admission, but coaches will let bowlers know that they may only have 2 adults per bowler in the bowling alley.

YMCA - Swimming

- There will not be any home meets for the swim team this season.

Auxiliary Gym - Indoor Track

- Moveable bleachers will be positioned to maximize social distancing.
- Spectators will be allowed to bring lawn chairs into the auxiliary gym.

Ticketing Information

- Tickets
 - Until further notice, tickets will not be available to the general public.
 - Each athlete will be allowed to purchase 2 tickets to a game in which they are a participant (basketball, cheer, dance and wrestling)
 - These tickets will be sold at the players' practice.
 - All spectators must have a ticket.
 - When and if our ticket numbers increase, all tickets for home games will be sold using GoFan (www.gofan.co). Tickets must be purchased in advance, and no cash will be accepted at the gate.
 - Venue specific capacities will be determined based on the ability to social distance.
 - All middle school students and younger must be accompanied by an adult at all times and sit with an adult.
 - Complimentary Passes WILL NOT be accepted (including coach's cards and staff badges).
 - Spectators must remain inside the venue; leaving and re-entering will not be permitted.
 - Tickets for away games will be sold at the discretion of the home team.
