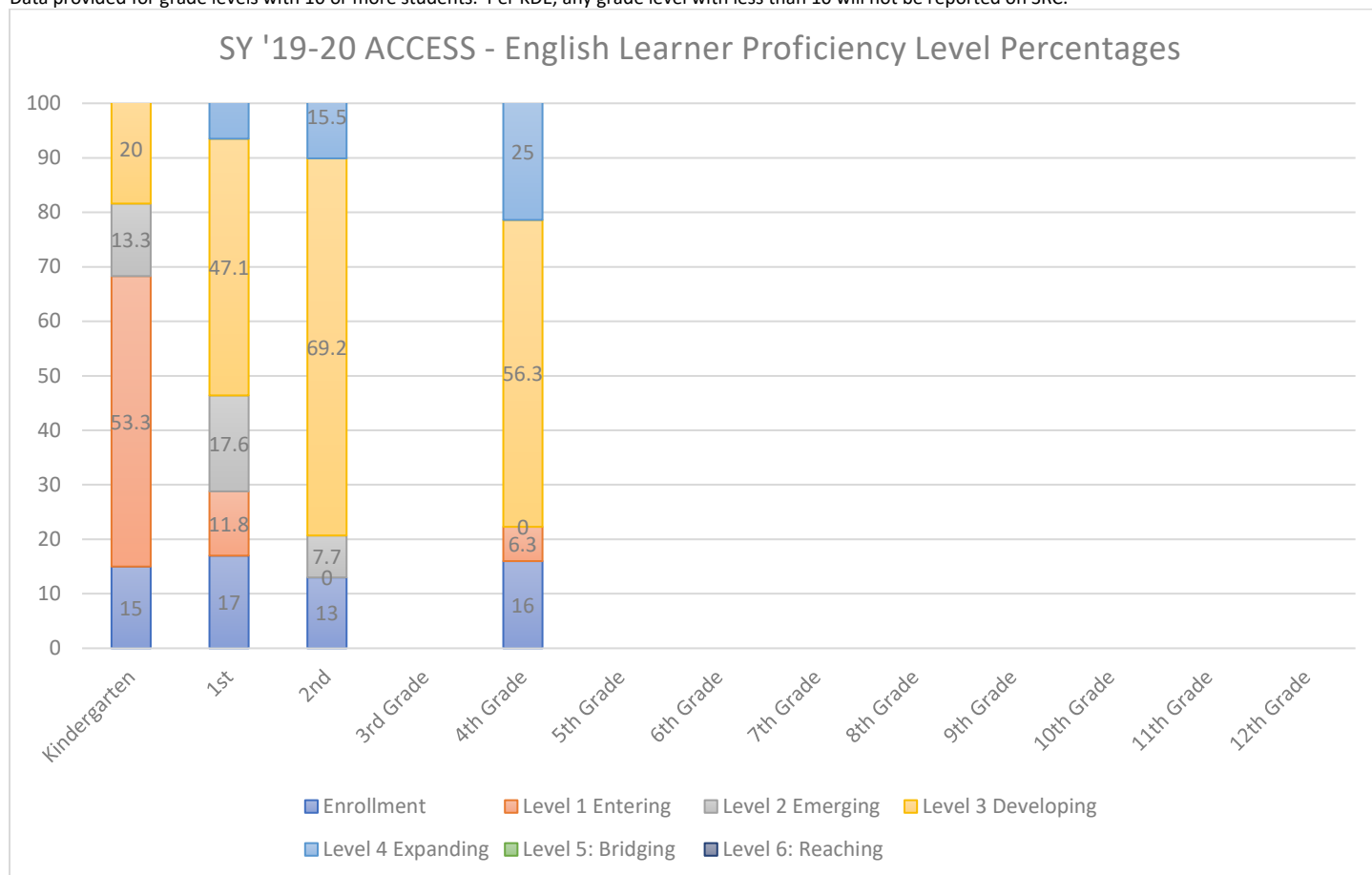

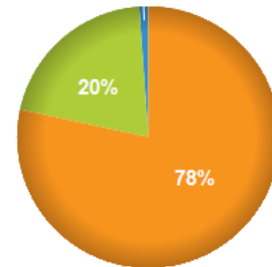

District Assessment Update – October 2020

Brigance Kindergarten Readiness Screener - provides an assessment of a child's development in five areas: Academic/Cognitive, Language, Development, Physical Development, Self-Help and Social-Emotional Development.

- 88 kindergarten students screened
- Screening must be completed “in-person”
- Higher percentage of students “Ready with Interventions” than last year due to COVID 19.
- Fall 2019 percentage of “Ready with Interventions” for kindergarten - approximately 65%
- Current Fall 2020 data
 - 78% Not Ready, need interventions
 - 20% Ready
 - 2% Ready with Enrichment
