 - Mrs. Stallkamp is starting Social Emotional Learning Lessons the week of November 30th with the 7th and 8th grade students. The overall theme of the lessons will be wellness. Each week, the students will be given a word/phrase to discuss, learn more about, and hopefully put into action in their academic and social lives. For example, the first word of the week is self-advocacy. The students will get a definition, complete a self-awareness and self-advocacy worksheet, and discuss ways in which they can be advocating for themselves during in-person and virtual learning in order to be successful. The goal of the SEL lessons Mrs. Stallkamp is providing is to have the students understand their strengths and weakness, learn how to develop their weaknesses to where they do not hinder their performance; play on their strengths, communicate with ones around them, take ownership of their academic successes and failures, and overall become (or stay) more successful.
