Intervention Wednesdays –

- a consistent schedule for the students that can easily be done at school or virtually
- a plan to address and implement individualized instruction to address needed skills
- <u>Gifted and Talented</u> Our gifted and talented teachers meet virtually every Wednesday morning with identified students to ensure they are getting their enrichments for all subjects. These very engaging sessions are impressive and always well attended by our students.
