

Student Attendance Boundaries - Non-Magnet Schools**ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CLUSTERS**

A student ~~Students~~ in grades kindergarten through five will be assigned to a school within the “cluster,” or group of schools, that includes their resides school, unless: (1) the student applied to and is granted admission assignment to a magnet school, magnet program, or optional program; or (2) the student applies for and is granted a transfer to another school outside their cluster.

MIDDLE SCHOOL RESIDES

A student ~~Students~~ in grades six through eight shall be assigned to the middle school that serves the area in which they reside unless: (1) the student applies to and is granted admission assignment to a magnet school, magnet program, or optional program; or (2) the student applies to and is granted a transfer to another school.

HIGH SCHOOL RESIDES

A student ~~Students~~ in grades nine through twelve shall be assigned to the high school that serves the area in which they reside unless: (1) the student applies to and is granted admission assignment to a magnet school, magnet program, career theme program, or optional program; or (2) the student applies to and is granted a transfer to another school.

DUAL RESIDES OPTION

Middle school and high school students ~~Students~~ living in the area of West Louisville identified on a Dual Resides Option map to be maintained on the Office of School Choice website. ~~XX area~~ shall be permitted to select either the school zoned closest to their home or a school zoned farther from their home.
