Magnet Education

MAGNET SCHOOLS AND PROGRAMS

The Board shall review and approve magnet schools, magnet programs, and optional programs which shall reflect the goals and philosophy of the District.

The Mission of the-magnet education in the District is to provide specialized educational options that attract a diverse population of students to cohesive, theme-based learning environments that promote excellence in student learning.

Magnet schools provide a whole-school approach to a unique curriculum. Magnet schools offer specialized instruction of theme-based education that appeals to student interests, talents, and abilities. Some magnet schools accept students from across the District; others accept applications from geographic areas of the District.

Magnet programs focus on a specific subject (such as technology) or provide a specialized learning environment. Students accepted into a magnet program become a full-time student of the school that offers it and attend the school for all classes. Some magnet programs accept applications from students throughout the district; others accept applications from specific geographic areas of the District.

Optional programs are small, specialized programs within a school. Students who live outside the school's attendance zone boundary or cluster may apply, but the District does not provide transportation for these students.

The <u>Superintendent</u> <u>District</u> and <u>its schools</u> shall develop and implement <u>equitable</u> <u>processes</u> equitable <u>eriteria</u>, <u>processes</u>, and <u>processes</u> that achieve this mission and support District expectations for all <u>magnet</u> <u>JCPS</u> schools, <u>magnet programs</u>, and <u>optional programs</u>.
