HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

RC Hinsdale Elementary School is in need of additional space and renovations to existing spaces. The proposed project involves the construction of a major cafeteria addition and a major classroom addition. The new cafeteria will free up the existing space for conversion into a new media center. It is necessary to completely renovate the existing kitchen area. The proposed classroom addition shall include 4 classrooms. The proposed classroom addition will allow for removal of the last modular classroom from the campus. The current media center space shall be renovated and converted into a science classroom, computer classroom, and art classroom. All other existing classroom spaces shall be renovated to include new HVAC, electrical, plumbing, fire protection, and interior finishes. The former administrative office will be renovated into special education resource rooms. The existing site has major parking and site circulation deficiencies. The proposed project is set to expand parking capacity, change circulation patterns, add site lighting, and playground improvements.
