## **MUNICIPAL ORDER 37-2020**

## A MUNICIPAL ORDER AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPLICATION FOR A THERMAL IMAGING CAMERA GRANT THROUGH THE KENTUCKY FIRE COMMISSION, FOR WHICH NO MATCH IS REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Fire Commission has established a goal that every fire department in the Commonwealth of Kentucky have at least one (1) thermal imaging camera and has established a grant to provide funding to pay the costs of such cameras; and

**WHEREAS,** the Owensboro Fire Department (OFD) seeks to apply for the grant to pay the cost of one (1) or more new thermal imaging cameras.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a grant application to be filed with the Kentucky Fire Commission for the purpose of applying for grant funds to pay the cost of one (1) or more thermal imaging cameras, for which no match is required from the City.

Section 2. That the Mayor, City Manager and appropriate staff members are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all other agreements, instruments or documents necessary and appropriate to effectuate and implement any grants awarded to the City.
